### NORMAL SEWING SUPPLIES;

SEWING MACHINE

ROTARY CUTTER AND MAT AND RULER – 28mm rotary cutter is best for this project

THREAD

TEMPLATE MATERIAL-I will have templates for you to use in class or to purchase .

DESIGN BOARD-a design board is necessary for this class. Can be as simple as a piece of foam board covered with batting or flannel.

### FABRIC;

For a quilt approx. 60"x60":

About 6 yards of fabrics. These can be fat quarters, scraps. Just be sure to include different values. The more fabrics the more interesting the quilt. A focal fabric is helpful.
